

## VERIFICATION OF ADC PRACTICAL EXAMINATION RESULTS

1. The ADC Practical Examination consists of a series of tasks which **together** contribute to the overall Pass/Fail grade awarded to a candidate. Candidates who fail an examination are advised of the outcome via the online Candidate Portal as soon as possible after the examination. This advice includes the result for each of the assessment tasks, and the overall grade awarded.
2. Candidates who fail the Practical Examination may request the ADC Director, Assessments and Examinations, to undertake a review of the relevant records to confirm the accuracy of the result notified to them for each task and for the overall grade in accordance with the decision of the examiners.
3. Candidates who fail the Practical Examination and who wish to seek verification of their results must apply to the ADC within 28 days of the date of that results are made available online. Candidates must complete the relevant application form (obtainable by contacting the ADC) and make payment of the application fee of AUD\$120.
4. Candidates will be advised in writing of the outcome of the verification process. The outcome will either confirm or amend their result.
5. The verification process does not provide candidates with detailed performance scores in the various components of the examination. The ADC does not release examination material, including examiners' working documents, to candidates.
